



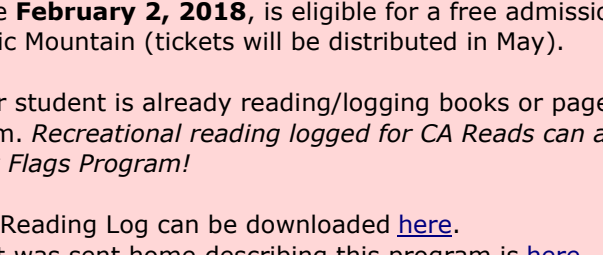

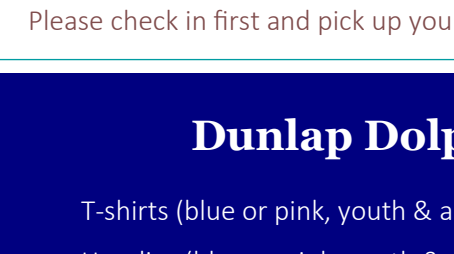
Hopefully your student is already reading/logging books or pages for the CA Reads Program. *Recreational reading logged for CA Reads can also be counted for this Six Flags Program!*

Available for purchase at Dunlap that day:

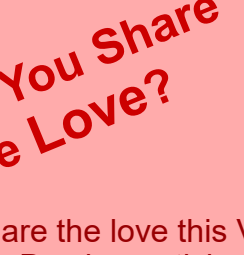
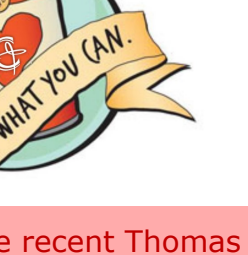

About Two Months Left to Log for California Reads!

The six-month California Reads school-wide read-a-thon ends on **March 31, 2018**. This year students earn **Emoji-themed prizes** as they turn in reading logs to their teachers. **Students who complete the program will earn a gold medal** at a special Parent-invited Award Assembly! Participants may read on their own, with family or friends, or during one-on-one tutoring sessions. Listening to someone else read, in any language, also counts toward total books/pages read. To earn a gold medal:

- Lower graders must read at least 96 books** Reading log [here](#)
- Upper graders must read at least 2,400 pages** Reading log [here](#)

Your involvement in the read-a-thon will help your child build literacy skills and develop a lasting love of reading. I look at this program as **parent driven** and teacher encouraged.

Any classroom that has the **ENTIRE** class earn the Gold medal will get to have their class participate in the end of the school year Classroom "Survivor" Games!

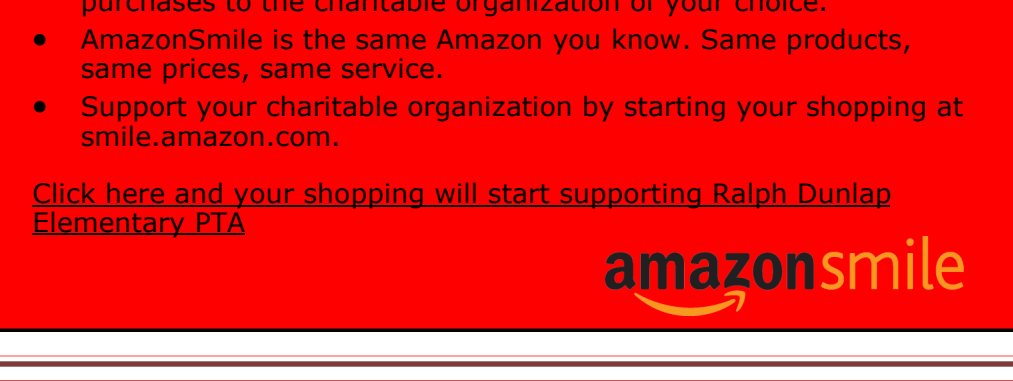

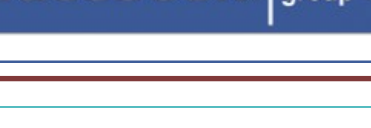
