

**Pizza certificates will be sent home in backpacks on Friday, April 13, 2018, with those students who will be receiving the California Reads Gold medal. Free Pizza certificates expire on May 1, 2018 so please mark your calendar and plan to use it right away if your child will be earning the Gold Medal!

We are five months into our six month California Reads reading program. Only ONE MONTH left to turn in log sheets! All reading up to March 31, 2018, can be logged and count toward CA Reads! All reading log sheets must be turned in to your child's teacher no later than April 9, 2018 (1st day back to school after Spring Break).

There is still plenty of time for your child to join in, earn prizes, and read toward their own "Gold Medal". Students can pick up CA Reads log sheets from their teachers. The log sheets are also posted on the <u>Dolphin Pod</u> (under the "files" tab) for your convenience to print at home.

Lower grade (K-3rd) need to read (or be read to) at least 96 books and upper grade (4th-6th) need to read (or be read to) at least 2400 pages by March 31, 2018 to earn the Gold Medal and be invited to the PARENT INVITED gold medal award ceremony. All reading logged October 1, 2017 – March 31, 2018 counts..... So log your reading, turn it in for prizes, and earn the Gold Medal! Please call or email with questions.
