**Membership Chair**—Do you enjoy data entry and busy work?

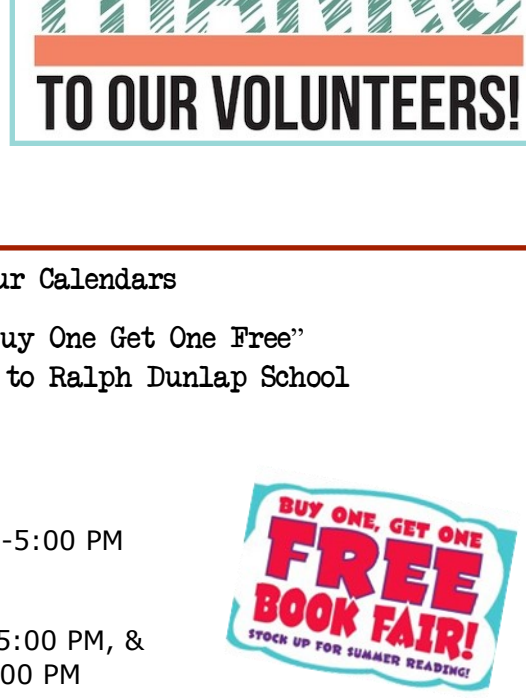
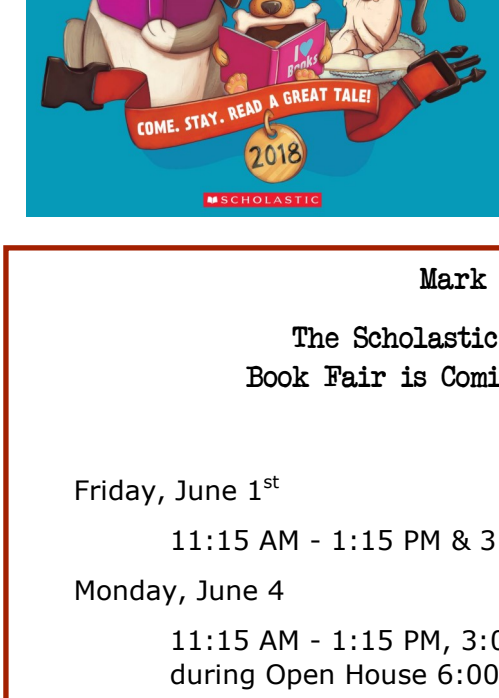
