




Dunlap Reads is a PTA-sponsored 6-month-long reading incentive program. This year it will run from November 1 - April 30. Students are encouraged to read outside of school (assigned homework reading time counts!!!), *individual* reading done at school may also be counted. Tally sheets will be handed out and collected monthly. Students at all grade levels will be counting the number of pages read. Books can be read either to the student or the student may read to themselves.

***All Books MUST be at or above the students individual reading level.

All students have the opportunity to earn monthly prizes, cumulative prizes for top readers, and there will be a prize drawing at the end of the 6 month program with lots of prizes.


- Every student that meets their monthly goal will receive 1 Prize and earn 1 Ticket for the prize drawing (tickets will be digitally tracked and not handed out to the students). Students who exceed their goal can continue to read and earn additional tickets. New prizes announced each month! example: A 3rd grader that reads 300 pages in a month would earn 1 ticket
 - A 3^{rd} grader that reads 600 pages in a month would earn 2 tickets A 3^{rd} grader that reads 900 pages in a month would earn 3 tickets
 - The Top 2 page readers, per month, in each grade will receive a Medal and a Homework pass. ***Students can only win once per year.
- Gold Medals will be awarded at the end, to all students that have either
- met each monthly page goal or met the total cumulative page goal
 The student in each grade with the highest number of pages read at the end of the 6 months will receive a trophy!




