Thanks to our always supportive families, Ralph Dunlap PTA earned nearly \$900 from Box Tops during just this school year alone!

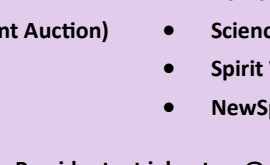
A New Sign is Coming!

Since Dunlap will be undergoing some safety improvements this summer as part of Measure G, we are able to coordinate the sign installation with work that the district will be doing at Dunlap.

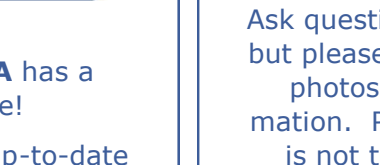

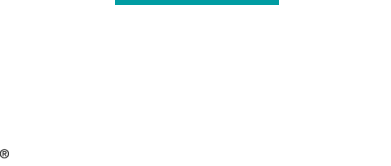

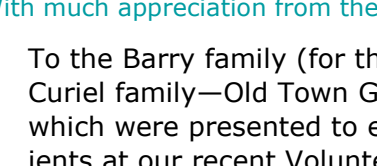
